PEND OREILLE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT

Public Utility District No. 1 of Pend Oreille County (the District), is requesting qualifications for consultants with a strong engineering staff to assist with preliminary design and construction engineering of a drinking water arsenic treatment project along with 900 feet of distribution replacement.

Project to include:

- Installation of arsenic, iron, and manganese removal treatment system rated at approximately 50 gpm located in the existing pump house. Work includes: treatment units, pump house upgrades, piping, controls, telemetry, electrical, backwash system, waste handling system, and other appurtenances.
- Installation of approximate length of 900 feet of up to 4-inch diameter water line. Water line work to include: pipe, valves, backfill, bedding, surface restoration, traffic control, and other appurtenances.
- Replacement of up to 51 service water meters.
- Other additional engineering work may be needed such as: design, construction inspection, hydrogeological assessment, cultural and environmental review, permits, public involvement, and preparation of bid documents.

The qualified individual will provide drinking water treatment experience with emphasis on arsenic, iron and manganese removal systems.

- 10 years in public domestic drinking water systems
- Licensed P.E. Civil Engineering
- Masters in Science (preferred)
- Demonstrated safety record
- Demonstrated experience on related contracts
