## **Ductless and Ducted Mini-Split Heat Pump (DHP) Project Installation Form**

All sections must be filled out by the installer at the time of installation. A copy of this completed form and the purchase receipt or invoice must be promptly submitted to the Pend Oreille PUD in accordance with utility policy in order to qualify for an incentive.

All systems must:

- 1. Be listed on BPA's DHP Qualified ProductList.
- 2. Be installed by a licensed contractor and according to the Best Practices for Installing Ductless Heat Pumps Guide.
- 3. Be installed in accordance with manufacturer specifications, including adherence to proper refrigerant charging.
- 4. Meet local utility requirements. Only one rebate may be claimed per electrically heated household.
