Contest Rules:

- Your artwork must be original and created by you.
- The artwork should be related to 811 safe digging practices and the "Know what's below, Call before you dig" theme.
- Artwork may not exceed 8.5" x 11" in size.
- Artwork may be computer-generated, photography, hand-drawn or a combination. (This includes the use of printer ink, markers, crayons, pencils, etc.) Stickers, copyrighted images, and/or slogans outside of the 811 slogan, "Know what's below. Call before you dig" may NOT be used.
- Only one submission allowed per person.
- Entries will not be returned.
- The PUD reserves the right to reproduce the artwork and use the names and age category of the winners.
- Artwork may appear at and/or on PUD platforms, including the website, social media, and advertising.
- A complete registration form must be submitted and accompany the artwork.
- Submissions that do not meet the above criteria will be disqualified.
