All poles must be picked up no later than Thursday, May 29, 2025. If the winning bidder fails to pick up the poles by 3:00 p.m. on May 29, 2025, the District reserves the right to award the poles to the next highest bidder.

Washington, PO Box 190, Newport, WA. 99156, or at the Box Canyon Dam Visitors Center, 7492 Hwy. 31, PO Box 547, Ione, WA. 99139 until 5:00 p.m., Thursday, May 15, 2025. Indicate "Sealed Bid" on the outside of the envelope. The bids will be opened Monday, May 19, 2025 and awarded at the May 20, 2025 Board meeting.
